

Zookeeping Qualification Practical - Colchester Zoo

The 1 week Practical Training programme at Colchester Zoo includes both theoretical and practical learning with a focus on experiential learning. Colchester Zoo is a 60-acre zoo located in Colchester, Essex, England – this well regarded zoo provides excellent, well established practical training and is home to over 200 species from all over the world including African elephants, Amur tigers and leopards, chimpanzees and orangutans, flamingos, penguins, ostriches, Komodo dragons, Aldabra tortoises and more.

The practical training is tailored to each small group and includes:

- Animal husbandry and management
- Animal enclosure maintenance
- Animal enclosure design activity with a focus on stakeholder needs
- Environmental Enrichment – designing, creating and implementing enrichment devices
- Primate and carnivore diet preparation and provision
- Conservation, education and research in zoos (including a personal project)
- Animal training – an insight into positive reinforcement training
- Specialist care of reptiles and invertebrates
- Licencing and records management at Colchester Zoo (Zoo record keeping with ZIMS training, introduction to zoo legislation and how it affects Colchester Zoo).

There will be involvement with numerous species including Primates, Reptiles, Carnivores and many more. This Zookeeper qualification is open to anyone aged 16 or over. No prior qualifications are necessary. Please note, accommodation and food is not included in the course fees. Course fees must be paid in full prior to attending the practical placement.
